

Homemade Haircuts Bring Beach-Vibes to Atlanta

The lively indie-rock band teases new songs, EP on southeast summer tour

Atlanta, Georgia - Up and coming indie rock band Homemade Haircuts will bring their energetic set to Smith's Olde Bar on July 19th, alongside New York City rockers Tennis Courts, Athens' Elijah Johnston, and Atlanta's own Parker Wierling.
